It's given them an all-weather, firm working base to clean the tanker and access to their storage container. As it means they're not standing in mud when it's wet, it's a thousand times better than before the pad was laid.

It has also provided them with an area to be used for truck maintenance and brigade training activities.

Other brigades appreciate the pad as well.

Asked what they thought made their application successful Paul reported that the Captain designed a form which provided all the information, and it was presented in a neat and detailed manner. The form included a Hurt Statement detailing the positives to flow in terms of OH&S factors which would improve if successful with their grant.
