## Mercury Incident

Scope	This Operations Bulletin applies to all operational personnel.
Background	At a recent event, a level of mercury contamination of CFA Personal Protective Clothing (PCC) was identified after the incident. This resulted in the isolation, testing and cleaning of additional equipment, appliances and locations. Medical monitoring is also being undertaken for those members involved.
	When the issue was identified, the response by local staff and volunteers was swift and professional with the health and wellbeing of our people a clear focus.
Details	There is currently an After Action Review being conducted on the specifics of this incident and as such, information relating to this incident is not currently available for dissemination.
	CFA is committed to ensuring the safety of its members at all times and this incident serves as a reminder of the risks we can face on a daily basis. Members need to continue to be diligent and be aware of the risks that incidents involving hazardous materials can pose to our health and safety.
	It is important for members to take all necessary steps to ensure that contaminates are not spread inadvertently beyond the scene of the incident.
