For information, below are items of interest approved from the VFBV Competition and Rules Committee for the information of Coaches, Competitors and Judges and Officials.

a) 2024 Team of the Year

Following the 2024 State Championships, the Committee approved the following as the 2024 Team of the Year:

Miller Anderson (Dandenong), Craig Briody (Wendouree), Aiden Couzens (Osborne Park A), Mark Mullins (Patterson River), Bailey Rhodes (Melton A), Matt Royal (Maryvale), Damon Sutton (Wendouree), Jordan Winsall (Osborne Park A), and Coach Anthony Rhodes (Melton)

b) Elevation and Relegation

<u>Elevation</u>: the Committee have agreed that Cohuna, Echuca A and Hoppers Crossing will be elevated from B Section to A Section.

Relegation: the Committee have agreed that no team will be relegated to B Section.

All other brigades will remain in the Section they competed in this year. As with previous years, the Committee will review the grading of any Brigade upon request.

c) Skills Workshop

The Committee will be running a skills workshop on Saturday 5th October at Melton.

This workshop will be conducted by experienced coaches, judges and officials and is open for all to attend. Any current or prospective competitors, coaches, judges and officials are encouraged to attend no matter your skill level.

Brigades attending are encouraged to bring along their equipment to be checked prior to the start of the competition season.

d) Judges at State Championships

Over the years, the number of judges available at the State Championships has been decreasing which is impacting on the running of the Championships. Entry requirements already stipulate that that each team is required to nominate a minimum of 2 non-competing members to act as a judge or official at the State Championships. If a Brigade enters more than 1 team, an additional non-competing member is required to be nominated also.

In order to ensure that there are enough judges and officials at the Senior Championship, teams entering in the Female Aggregate events will be required to nominate an additional judge or official to assist over the weekend.

Any prospective judges and officials are encouraged to attend the skills workshop in October to gain skills in advance of the competition season.

Failure to nominate the required number of judges may result in a Team being disqualified from competing in a track event.

e) Updated Rule Book

The Committee will be considering changes to the rule book at its September meeting. Changes are being considered to the rule relating to a team entering a second team at the Senior Championship. Once agreed to by the Committee an updated rule book will be available from the VFBV website for download. tinyurl.com/urban-champs

f) Female Aggregate events

The Committee have received a number of proposals relating to the Female Aggregate events and the potential introduction of a wet event into the Female Aggregate.

The Committee are requesting that competition associations trial incorporating the Wet Hose – Two Competitor event for Female competitors over the upcoming competition season and feedback to be forwarded to the Committee for consideration regarding potential inclusion at the State Championship.

The Committee have already agreed to changes for 2025 to allow two entries in the Female Aggregate events.

g) Junior State Championship Changes

The committee have approved two changes for the 2025 State Urban Junior Championship.

- 1. The start time has been moved and both days will now begin at 0900 hours
- 2. There will be two entries in the hydrant race per team for both the Under 14's and Under 17's.

h) 2024/2025 Competition Season

Applications have been sent to Competition Associations for the 2024/2025 Competition Season, these are due back to the VFBV office by **Monday 2nd September 2024.**

i) NSW State Championship

Attached to this circular is an invitation for brigades to consider attending the NSW State Championship to be held in Wagga Wagga on $24^{th} - 26^{th}$ October 2024.

If any CFA brigade wishes to attend this event or other interstate events, they are required to seek permission from the Association; which will then be forwarded to CFA for their approval. Requests to compete at interstate events can be forwarded to championships@vfbv.com.au

j) 2025 State Championship Dates

The 2025 State Urban Junior Championship will be held on the weekend of 22 and 23 March 2025 in Mooroopna. The Committee have also approved that the starting time for the Junior championship will be 9am both days.

The 2025 State Urban Senior Championship will be held in conjunction with the State Rural Championships on the weekend of 29 and 30 March 2025 in Mooroopna.
